

<u>Pastor's Corner</u> December 2025

Dear Samaria Family,

Christmas is a miraculous time of the year. The birth of Christ surpasses all miracles. There is a golden thread of redemption that flows through the entire Bible and culminates in the glorious birth of Christ, his sinless life, sacrificial death on the cross, and his victorious resurrection. His birth was prophesied by the Old Testament prophets Isaiah, Malachi and oth-

Another miracle birth was the birth of John the Baptist, a precursor and forerunner of Christ. Luke meticulously explains the unusual circumstances of John's birth. In Luke 1:5-24, the remarkable and unforgettable story unfolds. A priest named Zechariah, and his wife Elizabeth were righteous before the Lord and walked blamelessly in all the commandments and statutes of the Lord. To their great disappointment, they did not have children. While serving in the temple, an angel of the Lord appeared to Zechariah on the right side of the altar of incense. Gabriel told Zechariah that he would not be able to speak until John's birth. Interestingly, months later the angel Gabriel was sent by God to Nazareth to speak to a virgin named Mary. Astonishingly, Gabriel said, "Greetings, O favored one, the Lord is with you." Mary was understandably checked when Cabriel appropried that she standably shocked when Gabriel announced that she would bear a son. Gabriel reassured Mary, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you; therefore, the child to be born will be called holy-the Son of God." Then Gabriel shares more unbelievable news, "Your relative Elizabeth in her old age has also conceived a son and this is the sixth month with her who was called barren. For nothing will be impossible with God." Two incredible stories appear in the same chapter in the book of Luke. In Matthew 11:11, Jesus said, "Truly, I say to you, among those born of women there has arisen no one greater than John the Bap-tist." Jesus offers a historical appraisal that no other person can exceed.

Please invite your family and friends to join us for our Christmas Eve service at 5:30. It will be a special time of worship as we observe Communion. Christmas is the perfect time to reflect on God's perfect gift of salvation through Christ.
