*At AWANA WESTkids we want these verses to be retained for a lifetime. One of the ways we achieve this is by sticking together as we learn the verses. Each night the clubbers will say the verse that goes with the evening's lesson. They can make-up verses if they missed previous weeks, but we do not listen to verses for future weeks. We encourage you to review verses with your clubbers on a regular basis and not just on the review weeks. Learning these alongside your clubber is a great discipleship tool and shows them how important scripture memory is as they continue to grow in their faith and understanding of who God is.

Memorization Tips for Clubbers

Memorizing God's Word is one of the foundational goals of the AWANA program.

A key feature of AWANA is scripture memorization. We want kids to commit scripture to memory, so it is hidden in their hearts (Ps. 119:11).

5 Reasons To Memorize Scripture

- The Bible is true and flawless (Psalm 119:160; Psalm 18:30)
- 2 The Bible's Truth will last forever (Proverbs 30:5; Isaiah 40:8)
- The Bible shows us how to live (2 Tim 3:16-17; Psalm 119:105, 130; Matthew 7:24)
- 4 The Bible strengthens our faith (Romans 10:17; Romans 15:4)
- 5 Knowing the Bible pleases God (Proverbs 7:1-3; 1 John 5:3)

While we assist and encourage children to memorize scripture it is important that we convey the incredible importance and power of God's Word. Children should know why we put all the time and effort into memorizing verses. Below are some techniques to help your clubbers.

- Pray with your Clubber for God's help to memorize.
- Use repetition as much as possible by repeating the memory verse over and over again.
- Encourage your clubber to use the verse music that is available for each handbook.
 See our YouTube link (QR Code below)
- Use the verse cards we provided each AWANA night and have it posted somewhere as a reminder. In the car, on the bathroom mirror, on the refrigerator etc...
- Write individual words on 3".5" cards. Shuffle the cards and ask your Clubber to arrange them in order. When finished, clubbers can challenge other friends to a race.
 - Break up the verse into meaningful parts by putting parentheses around phrases. For example, Titus 3:5: (Not by works of righteousness) (which we have done) (but according to His mercy) (He saved us) (by the washing of regeneration) (and renewing of the Holy Ghost).

- Use the first letter of each of the words in the verses as a memory aid. For example, write out on a piece of paper Romans 5:1 in this way: T B J B F, W H P W G T O L J C. (Therefore, being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ.) Let the clubber try to recall the words of the verse just by looking at the first letter of each word of the verse. Let him or her keep practicing until he or she can say the verse without the letters.
- Write out the verse on a chalkboard or marker board (dry-erase board). Erase a word at a time to help a clubber learn his or her memory verse. Each time he or she correctly says the verse, erase another word until he or she knows the entire verse.
- Use the provided verse cards for clubbers to carry with them throughout the week.
 Encourage them to pull them out and review while they are waiting for the school bus or during other "down times" during the week.
 Suggest that they say the memory verses right before bedtime and first thing in the morning.



AWANA Clubs



Preschoolers LOVE Cubbies! Cubbies is for Preschool age kids (4 by September 1st & 5-year-olds.)

Cubbies nurtures the budding faith of preschoolers' and celebrates their desire to explore all that God has created. Whether it is the fun puppets, games, or all the friends, they can hardly wait for club time each week. Lessons focus on the greatness of God's love, His Word, and His Son Jesus Christ, the promised Savior.

Cubbies have two years of curriculum: Honeycomb and Appleseed.

Cubbies can earn four red apple emblem patches and four green apple emblem patches to add to their Cubbie vest. Emblems are earned by saying verses.

While other clubs have a bring a friend challenge, in Cubbies we try not to disrupt the routine that this age finds familiar and comforting so instead we encourage them to wear their club uniform to school on September 24 or do an outreach project!

If all verses are completed in the book – they will earn a Cubbie book completion award that corresponds with which book they completed. They will receive this at the AWANA awards ceremony.

SAVE THE DATE FOR AWANA AWARDS NIGHT: FIRDAY, MAY 8



Sparkies and Sparks ignites each child's curiosity about the people and events of the Bible, building a foundation of wisdom for knowing Christ. Club time features exciting games, relationship building with peers through play, handbook memory work, biblical teaching and music.

Sparkies is for kindergarten age children. They use the HangGlider handbook which is the first book of the AWANA Sparks handbooks. This handbook covers Genesis through Josua, with 12 exciting biographies that show kids the people in the Bible were real!

Sparks is for 1st and 2nd grade children. 1st and 2nd grade will make their way through the WingRunner handbook which covers scripture from Judges through the Birth of Christ and the SkyStormer handbook which covers scripture from the life of Christ through Revelation.

Sparkies fill a green flight badge with jewels.

Sparks – 1st Grade – fill a blue fight badge with jewels.

Sparks – 2nd Grade – fill a red flight badge with jewels.

They can earn 12 achievement jewels – 4 of each color.

A red jewel is awarded for completing Bible Drill sections

A green jewel is awarded for completing Activity section

A blue jewel is awarded for Club attendance

They will earn a "Go Mission" patch when they learn and help with the WESTkids AWANA mission project.

We do not have special "bring a friend" days but if at any point during the year they bring 2 friends they will receive a special "friendship" pin to add to their vest. See page 11 for alternatives.

If all verses are completed in the book they will earn a Sparks book completion award at the AWANA awards ceremony. The award they receive depends on how many Sparks books they have completed.

1st Book Award – HangGlider medal

2nd Book Award – WingRunner medal

3rd Book Award – Sparks Sparky Award Sculpture



The T&T (Truth & Training) club is for 3rd-5th grade kids. The T&T club teaches kids the truth of God's Word, trains them to follow Him and practice His grace. Club time features small group relationship building with leaders and peers, biblical teaching, and exciting games. Each handbook contains 30 Bible studies, memory verses, loads of extra credit, plus fun stories about T&T super agents.

During those three years we rotate between 4 books – Grace in Action, Agents of Grace, Evidence of Grace and Discovery of Grace. The book that is not done in their 3 year rotation is the book done to earn the AWANA Timothy award. It is offered to the clubbers in 4th and 5th grades. This book is done at the child's own pace and time schedule.

The four T&T handbooks:

Grace in Action – Kids will learn about the character and nature of God, information about the Bible, who Jesus is, and will understand more about grace.

Agents of Grace – Kids discover how to be Agents of Grace by learning about the attributes of God, the importance of biblical theology and the seven "I AM" statements of Jesus Christ from the Gospel of John.

Discovery of Grace – Kids will explore the value of the Bible and the impact of God's grace in our lives.

Evidence of Grace (Timothy Handbook) Kids continue to explore fundamental doctrines of Christianity. They will learn about the nature of God, structure and sequence of the Bible, redemption narrative and more

The first time a clubber finishes the Start Zone, they will receive a T&T puppy patch

Discovery Award Emblem – Clubbers earn a Discovery emblem for each four sections completed in the handbook. The emblems are placed on the clubber's pennant.

Section 1 - Red

Section 2 – Yellow

Section 3 – Blue



Extra Credit – Within each handbook section, there are "silver" and "gold" extra credit activities for the clubbers who want to dig deeper into God's Word. The silver exercises provide additional Bible study exercises, and the gold exercises typically provide four additional bible verses for memorization. These exercises can be completed in any order. A clubber will receive a silver emblem upon completion of all the siler sections in a handbook unit and a gold emblem upon completion off all gold section in a handbook unit. This is a combined total of 4 silver and 4 gold emblems if these extra credit sections are completed each year.

If all silver sections in the books are completed, they will receive a T&T shield patch.

If all gold sections in the book are completed, they will receive a "T" patch.

They will earn a "Go Mission" patch when they learn and help with the WESTkids AWANA mission project.

We do not have special "bring a friend" days but if at any point during the year they bring 2 friends they will receive a special "friendship" pin to add to their pennant. See page 11 for alternatives.

If all verses are completed in the book they will earn a T&T book completion award at the AWANA awards ceremony. The award they receive depends on how many T&T books they have completed.

1st Book Award – Alpha Award

**All clubs will receive their handbook and uniforms on our first club night. Please have your child bring their handbook and vest for, cubbies and sparks, with them each week to club. Throughout the week clubbers may use the book to study from, but please keep it in a safe place so it is not damaged or lost. T&T has bookwork that needs to be completed each week. We do charge a \$5 replacement fee if your child's book is lost or damaged beyond use. It is a good idea to have a dedicated AWANA bag to hold the handbook and vest. When clubbers say their verses each week, the small group leaders will initial completed sections.

Be prepared to say your verse before club starts Tennis shoes are best for game time *please leave flip flops and dress* shoes at home.

BE RESPECTFUL During opening ceremony participate in pledges and prayer

Listen to all AWANA leaders:

no talking back to leaders no leaving group on your own

Leave candy and toys at home

Always walk when not in games

During music - participate

During lesson time - raise hand to speak

During game time- participate and listen to leaders

BE FRIENDLY Be a good friend to other clubbers:

no hitting, spitting, pushing

no talking bad about others to them or to others

Look for newcomers and include them

Help one another

AWANA Code of Conduct

Become


Truly experiential ministry designed to help kids navigate a changing culture, experience God's presence and walk in the ways of Jesus.
