Week 1

Brite Idea: Jesus is Lord of all.

He Question: What does it mean that Jesus is Lord?

Jesus is God. He has ultimate authority over all things.

We Question: Will following the rules make us right with God?

No. We didn't do anything to make Jesus love us. We can't do anything that will make Him stop. He loved us so much that He died on the cross for our sin.

Week 2

Brite Idea: Jesus provides.

He Question: How is Jesus able to provide?

Jesus is God and He is Lord over all things. Nothing is impossible for Him and everything belongs to Him.

We Question: What can Jesus provide?

Everything we have is a gift from Jesus. He knows our needs. We can trust He is able to provide according to His perfect will.

The Transfiguration

(Mark 9:2-13; Luke 9:28-36)

Week 3

Brite Idea: Jesus reveals God's glory.

He Question: What is God's glory?

God's glory is His magnificence on display. By showing God's glory, Jesus showed He is fully God.

We Question: How can we respond to who Jesus is?

We can listen to Jesus and believe He is the Son of God. We can trust in Jesus as our Lord and Savior.

(Luke 10:38-42)

Week 4

Brite Idea: Jesus wants a relationship with us.

He Question: Why does Jesus care about people?

People are created in God's image and are the reason Jesus came to defeat sin. He loves us and wants a personal relationship with each of us.

We Question: How can we grow closer to Jesus?

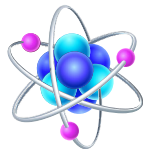
We grow closer to Jesus by spending time with Him through prayer, reading His Word, and worship.

Talk about the outcome of following people's rules vs. God's rules.	Try to guess each family member's favorite foods. READ TOGETHER: John 6:1–15 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 2 ----- Jesus provides. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Philippians 4:19 What needs will Jesus provide?	Play wants and needs. Have family members call out items and then guess if they are needs or wants.	PHILIPPIANS 2:10 –11 Why will every-one kneel before Jesus?	Provide for a need. Volunteer at a food bank or give away some clothes. Talk about how Jesus uses us to meet the needs of others.	Share the most extraordinary thing you have seen. READ TOGETHER: Mark 9:2-13 and Luke 9:28–36 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 3 ----- Jesus reveals God's glory. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Hebrews 1:3 What makes Jesus so amazing?	Wonder: What do you think it would have been like to be at the Transfiguration? What would you have thought or done?	PHILIPPIANS 2:10 –11 What will everyone confess about Jesus?	Have each member finish the sentence, I believe Jesus...	Play would you rather: household chores. READ TOGETHER: Luke 10:38–42 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 4 ----- Jesus wants a relationship with us. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Jeremiah 31:3b How did God show how much He loves us?	Who are you most like in the story, Mary or Martha? Why?	PHILIPPIANS 2:10 –11 Is Jesus Lord of your life? Why or why not?	Come up with a plan as a family about how you can spend time with Jesus together.	Hide something and have each family member try to find it. READ TOGETHER: Luke 15:11–24 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
