TWENTY | TWENTY is a call to begin the year by fixing our eyes on God. Just as clear vision allows us to move with confidence, spiritual clarity allows us to live with purpose. When our focus is right, our direction becomes clear.

This season of prayer and fasting is not about striving or discipline alone. It is about creating space—space to listen, space to realign, and space for God to sharpen our spiritual sight. In a world full of noise, distraction, and urgency, we are intentionally slowing down so we can hear God's voice more clearly.

We believe that vision is not something we manufacture; it is something God reveals. As we seek Him together, He clarifies our priorities, heals what has been blurred, and prepares our hearts for what lies ahead.

TWENTY | TWENTY is an invitation to start the year rooted, focused, and aligned. It is a moment to lay aside distractions, set our hearts on Christ, and allow God to shape our vision for our lives, our families, and our church.

As we seek the Lord together, we trust that clarity will come—and with clarity, the courage to step forward in faith.

ENGAGE 2026

*“No one who **puts a hand to the plow** and looks back is fit for the Kingdom of God.” - Luke 9:62*

ENGAGE 2026 is a reminder that God’s work is not accomplished by spectators, but by people who are willing to step in, show up, and participate in what He is doing. The vision challenges us to live with focus—to engage the plow, break new ground, and trust God with the harvest. Whether or not we see the full outcome, we are called to be faithful in the work He has placed before us.

ENGAGE 2026 is built around four guiding values that shape how we live, serve, and grow together:

Faithful — Engaged to Christ

We remain rooted in a growing relationship with Jesus. Our faithfulness begins not with what we do, but with who we belong to.

Focused — Engaged Attention

We fix our eyes on what matters most. In a world full of distraction, we choose presence, obedience, and spiritual attentiveness.

Fruitful — Engaged in the Work

We actively participate in God’s mission. Every gift matters, every person has a role, and every act of obedience produces Kingdom impact.

Fearless — Engaged in the Battle

We step forward with courage and faith, trusting God in moments of uncertainty and standing firm in spiritual opposition.

ENGAGE 2026 is an invitation for every person, every family, and every generation to take ownership of the mission God has entrusted to us. As we seek the Lord together, may He give us the clarity to see, the faith to obey, and the perseverance to press forward.

How to Use This Guide

This guide is designed to help you slow down, focus your heart, and seek God intentionally during this season of prayer and fasting. There is no right or wrong pace—only a posture of openness and obedience.

Each day includes a Scripture, space for a devotional thought, an application/declaration, and a prayer focus. Set aside a consistent time each day to read, pray, and reflect. Even a few quiet minutes with God can bring clarity when approached with sincerity.

Choose a fast that fits your season of life and health. The goal is not perfection, but attentiveness. When you feel hunger, distraction, or resistance, allow those moments to redirect your attention back to prayer.

Use the reflection spaces to write what God is showing you. These notes may become reminders of God's faithfulness and guidance throughout the year.

If you miss a day, receive the gift of God's grace and continue to plow forward. Spiritual growth happens through faithfulness, not guilt.

Above all, approach this journey with expectancy. As you seek the Lord, trust that He will speak, lead, and bring clarity—one day at a time.

Fasting is the intentional practice of setting something aside in order to focus more fully on God.

It is not about deprivation or religious performance, but about creating space for spiritual clarity and deeper connection with the Lord.

During this season, choose a fast that is meaningful, sustainable, and appropriate for your health and life circumstances. The purpose is not to compare or compete, but to posture your heart to hear from God. What you give up should lead you back to prayer.

Common fasts include a Daniel Fast, fasting one meal a day, fasting from sun-up to sun-down, or fasting from specific items such as sugar, caffeine, or media. Some may choose to fast social media or entertainment in order to reduce distraction and increase attentiveness to God's presence.

When you feel hunger, pause and pray. Let physical reminders become spiritual prompts. When distractions surface, return to Scripture. When the fast feels difficult, ask God for strength. And if you miss a moment or struggle along the way, receive grace and continue forward. Consistency matters more than perfection.

Fasting is meant to sharpen focus, quiet the noise, and realign our hearts with God's will. As you fast, remain attentive to what the Holy Spirit is revealing. Write down what God shows you, listen for His voice, and respond in obedience. Above all, remember that fasting is not about what you are giving up—it is about Who you are drawing near to. As you seek the Lord with sincerity, trust that clarity, renewal, and direction will follow.



DAY 1 - VISION BEGINS WITH WORSHIP

Scripture: *Isaiah 6:1-8*

Observation:

Application: *I see God rightly first and everything else comes into focus.*

Prayer: *“Lord, open my eyes to see Your glory above everything else.”*



DAY 2 - REMOVE SPIRITUAL BLINDSPOTS

Scripture: *Psalm 139:23-24*

Observation:

Application: *God will reveal my heart and lead me so that nothing will cloud my sight this year.*

Prayer: *“Lord, search my heart and reveal anything that blocks my vision.”*



DAY 3 - GOD'S VOICE IS MY PRIORITY

Scripture: *John 10:22-30*

Observation:

Application: *I will prioritize listening to His voice, I will know Him, and follow Him.*

Prayer: *“Lord, help me to recognize Your voice clearly and obey Your instruction quickly.”*



DAY 4 - FRESH AWE OF GOD

Scripture: *Psalm 27:1-4*

Observation:

Application: *My vision becomes clear when I behold the beauty of the Lord in His presence.*

Prayer: *“Lord, restore my wonder and my passion for Your presence.”*



DAY 5 - GOD'S WORD LIGHTS MY PATH

Scripture: *Psalm 119:97-105*

Observation:

Application: *God's Word informs my decisions and defines my direction.*

Prayer: *"Lord, illuminate the steps that I need to take this year."*



DAY 6 - MY IDENTITY AS GOD SEES ME

Scripture: *1 Peter 2:9-10*

Observation:

Application: *I am chosen, I am called, and I have been commissioned by God.*

Prayer: *“Lord, show me my identity in Christ through Your Word.”*



DAY 7 - HEAL THE HURTS THAT DISTORT VISION

Scripture: *Psalm 147:1-6*

Observation:

Application: *My past wounds and experiences will not hijack my future.*

Prayer: *“Lord, heal the places of my heart that still shape my decision making.”*



DAY 8 - RENEWED MIND, RENEWED VISION

Scripture: *Romans 12:1-2*

Observation:

Application: *The Word of God is powerful to renew my mind so I see myself the way God does.*

Prayer: *“Lord, transform my life by renewing my mind and align my thoughts with Yours.”*

DAY 9 - BREAK PATTERNS THAT BLUR VISION

Scripture: *Hebrews 12:1-2*

Observation:

Application: *I release to God all the burdens and weights that slow me down.*

Prayer: *“Lord, help me to lay aside the sin and the distractions.”*



DAY 10 - CALLED WITH PURPOSE

Scripture: *Ephesians 2:1-10*

Observation:

Application: *I am God's workmanship and created in Christ for His good works.*

Prayer: *"Lord, reveal the assignments You have prepared in advance for me."*



DAY 11 - A UNIFIED CHURCH

Scripture: *John 17:20-23*

Observation:

Application: *When I am aligned to the mission of Christ, I walk with love, clarity, and unity.*

Prayer: *“Lord, make us one family, one team, one church with one story, one heart, and one vision.”*



DAY 12 - ENGAGE THE PLOW

Scripture: *Luke 9:57-62*

Observation:

Application: *God needs me to engage the plow with courage and advance His Kingdom forward.*

Prayer: *“Lord, give us the perseverance needed to break new ground this season.”*



DAY 13 - OUR CHURCH ASSIGNMENT

Scripture: *Matthew 28:18-20*

Observation:

Application: *Faith Assembly of God exists so people with real needs encounter a real God.*

Prayer: *“Lord, reveal to me how our church is supposed to reach our city.”*



DAY 14 - VISION FOR THE NOW GENERATION

Scripture: *Psalm 78:1-4*

Observation:

Application: *We are responsible to create spaces where the Now Generation can know and grow in Christ.*

Prayer: *“Lord, show us how to disciples and empower young people.”*



DAY 15 - VISION FOR OUR COMMUNITY

Scripture: *Jeremiah 29:5-7*

Observation:

Application: *We seek God for the peace and prosperity of our city.*

Prayer: *“Lord, give us a heart for Mililani, our neighbors, and the underserved in our community.”*



DAY 16 - DISCERNMENT FOR DECISIONS

Scripture: *Proverbs 3:5-6*

Observation:

Application: *The Lord directs my steps daily and clearly leads me on the right path.*

Prayer: *“Lord, guide every plan and every decision we make this year.”*

DAY 17 - FAITH FUELED OBEDIENCE

Scripture: *Hebrews 11:1-12*

Observation:

Application: *I will not hesitate to trust the faithfulness of the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.*

Prayer: *“Lord, give us courage to obey even when I don’t have the full picture.”*



DAY 18 - BELIEVING FOR PROVISION

Scripture: *Philippians 4:19-20*

Observation:

Application: *God is able to supply more than enough to meet every demand of my life.*

Prayer: *“Lord, provide the resources for ministry, missions, and community impact this year.”*



DAY 19 - VISION FOR FAMILIES

Scripture: *Joshua 24:14-15*

Observation:

Application: *I will seek God for 20/20 spiritual vision this over my household this year.*

Prayer: *“Lord, find favor over each and every family in our church as we choose to seek and serve You.”*



DAY 20 - A HEART FOR THE HARVEST

Scripture: *John 4:34-38*

Observation:

Application: *The Lord has prepared the fields for harvest and has called me to bring them home.*

Prayer: *“Lord, help us to see and love people the way that You see and love people.”*



Prayer Points

PRAY FOR OUR NATION

PRAY FOR OUR STATE LEADERS

Pray for officials in our state governments to have pure motives as they lead with integrity, compassion, and wisdom.

THURSDAY

PRAY FOR OUR LOCAL LEADERS

Pray that our city and regional government leaders will have unity, wisdom, and discernment as they deliberate over local affairs.

FRIDAY

PRAY FOR OUR JUDICIARY

Pray that judges across the nation would rule with integrity, justice, and righteousness.

SATURDAY

PRAY FOR OUR CHURCHES

Pray that God will anoint our churches to serve their communities and proclaim Jesus through the power of the Holy Spirit.

A COMMISSIONING PRAYER FOR THE YEAR AHEAD
