# The Wilderness Wanderings

Lesson Text: Numbers 13–33

Focus Verses: Numbers 14:30-31 (NKJV)

Theme: I will believe God will do what He says.

Truth: God desires His covenant people to believe His promises.

### **Opening Thought**

Israel had seen miracles—Red Sea opened, manna fell, water flowed—yet when it was time to step into promise, fear took control. They forgot who brought them out. (Numbers 14:30–31)

#### **Lesson Connection**

Fear and unbelief slander God's faithfulness. Our words can either honor His promise or undermine His power. (Numbers 14:11)

### The Twelve Spies

Ten spies saw giants; two saw God. Faith sees possibility where fear sees problems. (Exodus 3:17; Numbers 13:30, 32–33; Proverbs 18:21)

#### The Faithless Generation

Unbelief delayed their destiny. Fear made them long for Egypt instead of pressing toward promise. (Numbers 14:1–4, 34, 18–19; Hebrews 10:38–39)

#### A Faithful Generation

Joshua and Caleb stood firm. Their faith outlived the fear of their generation. (Numbers 14:9; Joshua 14:10–12; Deuteronomy 5:32–33; Jeremiah 31:33; Romans 8:37)

## Internalizing the Message

The stones of past victories remind us of God's faithfulness. If we get the man right, the world will be right. (2 Corinthians 5:17)

## **Prayer Focus**

Faith – Luke 17:5; Speech – Psalm 141:3; Obedience – Galatians 5:1; Courage – 'Make me a Joshua or Caleb in my generation.'

## **Closing Declaration**

I will believe. God will do what He says. (Numbers 23:19)
