Ebenezer Youth Apprenticeship (level two)

The Ebenezer Youth Ministry Apprenticeship aims to help someone in a space who has discerned ministry as their vocational calling (level one) and is moving towards vocational ministry (now level two). The successful applicant will then plug into a role that requires 15–20 hours of their week. A Youth Ministry Apprenticeship will be developed through intentional growth in the following areas: 1. Character, 2. Teamwork, and 3. Competency. While being built into these areas, a Youth Ministry Intern will be expected to provide service to our youth ministry with guidance from their Ministry Mentor in the following areas of ministry: 1. Shepherding, 2. Administration, 3. Communication, 4. Vision.

How this is Internship going to be done?

This apprenticeship will be filtered through three core values; 1. Character, 2. Teamwork, 3. Competency,

1. Character development

- 1. Weekly meeting with the Ebenezer Youth Core Team (1. Youth Pastor(s), 2. Youth Coordinator(s), 3. Youth intern(s), 4. Youth Apprentice(s))
- 2. Weekly mentorship with ministry mentor
- 3. Taking time in internshup to read each week
- 4. Ministry mentors will set up times with other staff in church for other pastors to learn from as time permits

2. Teamwork

Learning what it means to function in a leadership capacity in the church,

- Sitting in on a staff meeting
- Joining the youth lead team
- Getting behind the scenes on everything that happens at youth by walking alongside Youth Pastor

3. Competencies of the 'do' in apprenticeship:

- 1. Shepherding
- 2. Speaking
- 3. Administration
- 4. Vision

What a week may look like in hours

5 hours- Character development (mentorship from YP and others, reading, etc.)

- 6 hours- Admin
- 1 hour- teamwork
- 1 hour vision
- 3 hours- Jr youth on Tuesdays
- 3 hours- Sr youth on Wednesdays
- 4 hours- Flex for a given week (Shepherding/ mentoring youth, speaking prep, etc.)
- = 15-20 hours

The length of the Apprenticeship

The length of an Internship will be arranged on a case-by-case basis. Because these youth Internships are designed to move one towards full-time ministry the investment could be as short as 3 months or as long as 3 years!
