DIGGING DEEPER:

1. What would your children say is your primary hope for them based on what you emphasize through your time investment and conversations? If you don't currently have close relationships with children in your home or family what would other people see as the priority in your life?
2. How do we make the discipleship of our family a natural part of our lives so it isn't dreaded and doesn't seem forced?
3. Answer this question honestly.... How dedicated are you currently to becoming a disciple who looks more like Jesus?
4. David Platt has said that "Making disciples of Jesus is the overflow of the delight in being disciples of Jesus." With his quote in mind, what is delighting in being a disciple of Jesus?
5. Why aren't more men mature enough, and bold enough to follow Joshua's example and without getting the family's permission declare "my house will serve the Lord?"
6. What is the greatest "as for me" spiritual need in your life right now?
7. Since perfection isn't possible, what does persistence in discipleship look like?
