DIGGING DEEPER:

- 1. Where does your daily life most clearly reveal that you believe you still have “plenty of time”?**
- 2. What obedience have you delayed by labeling it “later,” even though you already know what God is asking of you?**
- 3. In what ways have you settled into a version of Christianity that is comfortable, minimal, or convenient rather than urgent and costly?**
- 4. If you had to give an account today—not of your intentions, but of your actual actions—what area of your life would trouble you most?**
- 5. What is one specific change that would make 2026 clearly different if you lived with eternity in view?**
- 6. Where might we be the most at risk of agreeing with Romans 14:12 theologically while resisting it practically—both as individuals and as a church?**
- 7. If someone closely observed your life for one month, what would they conclude actually shapes your decisions more than eternity?**
- 8. When your life “vanishes,” what do you realistically expect to still be bearing fruit because you lived?**
