1 Corinthians 3:11 For no one can lay any foundation other than the one we already have–Jesus Christ. **12** Anyone who builds on that foundation may use a variety of materials–gold, silver, jewels, wood, hay, or straw. **13** But on the judgment day, fire will reveal what kind of work each builder has done. The fire will show if a person's work has any value. **14** If the work survives, that builder will receive a reward. **15** But if the work is burned up, the builder will suffer great loss. The builder will be saved, but like someone barely escaping through a wall of flames. (*NLT*)

And all were judged according to their deeds. **14** Then death and the grave were thrown into the lake of fire.  - ► Final moments where God is calling for people to repent (Tribulation)
 - ► God is both calling people to repent and passing out judgement.

 - Noah and the ark
 - Armageddon (Before Millennial Reign)
 - Final Revolt (After Millennial Reign)

Nothing like it has been seen before or will ever be seen again. **3** Fire burns in front of them, and flames follow after them. Ahead of them the land lies as beautiful as the Garden of Eden. Behind them is nothing but desolation; not one thing escapes. 4 They look like horses; they charge forward like warhorses. 5 Look at them as they leap along the mountaintops. Listen to the noise they make-like the rumbling of chariots, like the roar of fire sweeping across a field of stubble, or like a mighty army moving into battle. 6 Fear grips all the people; every face grows pale with terror. 7 The attackers march like warriors and scale city walls like soldiers. Straight forward they march, never breaking rank. 8 They never jostle each other; each moves in exactly the right position. They break through defenses without missing a step. 9 They swarm over the city and run along its walls. They enter all the houses, climbing like thieves through the windows. **10** The earth guakes as they advance, and the heavens tremble. The sun and moon grow dark, and the stars no longer shine. **11** The Lord is at the head of the column. He leads them with a shout. This is his mighty army, and they follow his orders. The day of the Lord is an awesome, terrible thing. Who can possibly survive? (NLT)

 - Pagan army and heavenly army (throughout Joel)

 - No stopping this army
 - Perfect unity
 - Number when Greek and Hebrew say something cannot be counted it is beyond their counting. They at that time stopped counting in the hundreds of millions.

- How do we reconcile God of mercy with God of wrath?
 - Sword of God / Word of God Double edged
 - ► One side Mercy and Redemption
 - One side Vengeance and Justice
 - People argue that God of the Old Testament and God of the New Testament are different.
 - God of the Old Testament is a brutal God.
 - God of the New Testament is a God of mercy.
 - Can God enact mercy and justice at the same time? Yes.
 - ► The Holy Spirit has been the difference holding back wickedness, in the New Testament era.

Joshua 10:22 Then Joshua said, "Remove the rocks covering the opening of the cave, and bring the five kings to me." 23 So they brought the five kings out of the cave—the kings of Jerusalem, Hebron, Jarmuth, Lachish, and Eglon. 24 When they brought them out, Joshua told the commanders of his army, "Come and put your feet on the kings' necks." And they did as they were told. 25 "Don't ever be afraid or discouraged," Joshua told his men. "Be strong and courageous, for the Lord is going to do this to all of your enemies." (*NLT*)
