Part 6 - Awareness, Faith, and Peace

Introduction

As we close this series on situational awareness, we want to return to the foundation: this is not about fear. It's about peace.

Some people think preparing for danger shows a lack of faith. But Scripture paints a different picture.

Think of Nehemiah. As he rebuilt the wall around Jerusalem, he prayed—and he posted guards. Faith and strategy worked hand in hand.

Jesus told his disciples to be wise as serpents and innocent as doves. Paul escaped a city by being lowered in a basket through the wall. Proverbs tells us the prudent see danger and take refuge.

God gives us tools. Awareness is one of them.

Healthy situational awareness helps you rest in peace, not live in fear. Because you've already made plans, you can set aside anxiety and rest in Him. If you notice tension rising, you know when to pull back. Because you've practiced, you don't have to panic.

One missionary we trained said that learning awareness made her feel free, not anxious. She said, "I used to walk blindly, praying I'd be fine. Now I walk wisely, praying and watching. I feel safer — and more effective."

That's the heart of this whole series.

- Be informed. Know what's normal where you live.
- Be observant. Learn to spot what's out of place.
- Be prepared. Know your options before you need them.

- And above all—walk with peace and wisdom, not fear.
