Our Beliefs

...man willingly fell to sin, though he was created good, for God said, “Let us make man in our own image, after our likeness.” Thereby he incurred physical and spiritual death, which is separation from God.

(Genesis 1:26-27, Genesis 2:17, Romans 5:12-19)

...salvation is necessary for all men. Salvation is received through repentance toward God and faith toward the Lord Jesus Christ.

(John 3:3, 2 Corinthians 7:10, Titus 3:5-7)

...in the practice of two ordinances – (1) Water Baptism by immersion after repentance of sins and receiving Christ as Savior and (2) Holy Communion, or the Lord's Supper, as the symbolic remembrance of Christ's suffering and death.

(Matthew 28:19, Romans 6:4); (1 Corinthians 11:26)

...the Baptism of the Holy Spirit is an experience all believers are entitled to, which empowers believers for witnessing and effective service.

(Acts 1:8, Acts 2:4, 1 Corinthians 12:1-31)

...the Church has a Mission – to turn people lost in their sin into mature followers of Christ.

(Ephesians 1:22-23, Hebrews 12:23, 1 Corinthians 14:12)

...Divine Healing from sickness is provided for in the atonement, and is the privilege of all believers.

(Isaiah 53:4-5, Matthew 8:16-17, James 5:14-16)

...the Blessed Hope (or Rapture) when all believers who have died will rise from their graves and will meet the Lord in the air, and Christians who are alive will be caught up with them, to be with the Lord forever.
