We, as a church family, have helped so many in our own church family, as well as meeting local, national, and global needs, because of your generosity. God's Word is very clear:

"15 If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, 16 and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that?"

(James 2:15-16, ESV)

Our annual SWC offering meets many needs, both at home in Henry and surrounding counties, Tennessee State Missions, as well as national and global mission efforts. Through SWC, we also support local benevolence, helping TVCC families in need of short-term assistance and others in our community who need help. We support our local men's Hope Center, a year-long in-house recovery center. Other ministries we support include Tomorrow's Hope Pregnancy Medical Clinic, R.E.A.L. Hope Youth Center—an after-school program for elementary children, and the Carl Perkins Center, to name a few. When you give through SWC, you also help send mission teams to Africa and support the four churches and seven schools of New Hope Missions International in Haiti.

Remember, **Showing We Care** is not something we have to do but something we want to do; it's an invitation, not a provocation. Together, we give, not to the church, but to promote the kingdom of God through the church, the people He chose to use to reveal His Son, and to bless the world.
