

Are You Saved From Something or Are You Saved FOR Something?

Recently, I was listening to one of Billy McGuiggan's sermons when he asked the question, "Were you saved from something or were you saved from something?" This question caught my attention and caused me to reflect on what my purpose in life is?

That question brought me to Revelation 2:1-7, the letter to the church at Ephesus. Here is a list of praises and complaints to the church at Ephesus. Jesus knew their deeds, both good and bad. They couldn't tolerate wicked men. They tested those who claimed to be apostles. They persevered and endured hardships for serving Jesus. They hated the practices of the Nicolaitans, which Jesus also hated.

That ended the positives. Here are the negatives. You have lost your first love. Remember how far you have fallen.

Here is how they should correct their problems. Repent and do what you did at first. If no repentance – no lampstand. Hear what the Spirit says. To him who overcomes, I will give the right to eat of the tree of life which is in the paradise of God.

How do we lose our first love? Scott Meyer states one reason is, "When personalities become more important than purpose, the church forgets who it belongs to." Do we need a revival in our personal lives? Do we remember how excited and convicted we were for Jesus when our sins were forgiven through baptism? Has this passion increased or declined during our walk with Jesus? How active are we in the ministries at Tusculum? Are we listening to the Spirit? Are we content to be saved from something, or do we understand that we are saved for something? Acts 2:42 And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and prayers.
