Now Pray

Several years ago, a brother asked for prayers during a casual conversation. I can't say that he expected us to stop right then and go to the Father in prayer. To be honest, I did not expect to do that either. But at that moment, I said, "Why don't we pray right now?" That unplanned event changed my life.

Since then, similar opportunities have occurred with family, friends, coworkers, and even total strangers. Let's be honest; when someone asks for our prayers, how often do we actually remember their request later in the day? Life is busy, and sometimes we simply forget to go to God on behalf of someone else.

You may remember; several years ago, *The Prayer of Jabez* was a bestselling Christian book. It was based on Jabez's prayer for blessing and protection found in 1 Chronicles 4:10. It reads: *Jabez called upon the God of Israel, saying, "Oh that you would bless me and enlarge my border, and that your hand might be with me, and that you would keep me from harm so that it might not bring me pain!" And God granted what he asked.*

As a result of that book and that verse, many readers became much more intentional in prayer - more urgent and immediate. When a brother or sister asks for our prayers, yes, they are asking for God's help, but aren't they also asking us for encouragement or simply a hug? If someone thinks so much of you that they would ask you to speak to God on their behalf, try to be in that moment and go to God in prayer. Chances are very good that both of you will be blessed.
