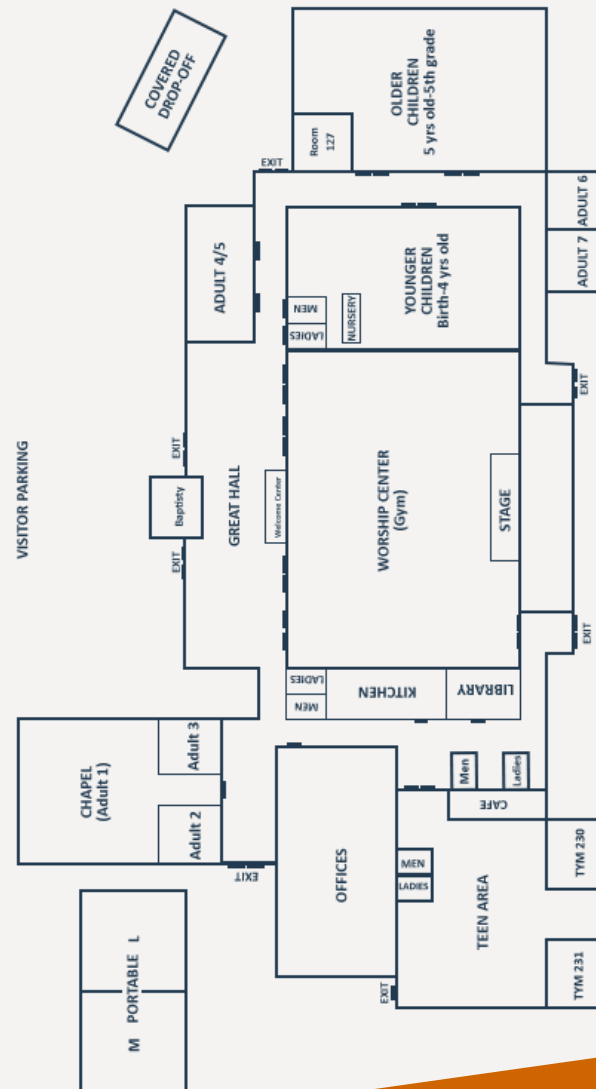


Monthly Fellowship Meal
