All God Has Next Steps
from last Sunday's message by Jody Gambrell,
"New Year: Deeper Roots":

1. **Choose a daily, root deepening rhythm.** Commit to a simple daily quiet time as you begin 2026.
2. **Identify what's weakening your roots.** Ask God to reveal one area to surrender. Pray for the courage to trust His pruning.
3. **Write a "root" prayer for the year.** Keep it in your Bible and return to it often. Examples:
"Jesus, keep me close to You this year."
"Lord, grow deep roots in my faith."
"Teach me to depend on You daily."
