WON'T YOU BE A NEIGHBOR? Four-Week Sermon Series

"Won't You Be A Neighbor: Loving Like Jesus"

Next Steps from last Sunday's message: "Won't You Be A Neighbor: The Important and Ignored"

1. This week, I'll pray: "Lord, show me someone I've been overlooking." Ask God to open your eyes this week to someone you normally walk past: someone in your neighborhood, your workplace, your school, or even this church. Pray not just for their needs, but for your heart to see them the way Jesus sees you. Sometimes the person you overlook is the very person God is trying to reach through you.

2. This week, I'll be Interruptible.

Choose to hold your plans loosely this week. When someone needs your attention, help, or time, don't see it as an interruption, see it as an invitation. You might discover that the very thing you thought was in your way is actually the way God is working.

3. This week, I'll encourage out loud.

Speak one intentional word of encouragement every day this week. Tell someone, "I see you," "I appreciate you," or "I'm praying for you." Never underestimate how powerful a few words can be, especially to someone who feels invisible.

This past Sunday, October 26, the Deacon Body voted unanimously to join a motion from the Stewardship Leadership Team to accept the 2026 Mission & Ministry Plan (Budget) proposal submitted from the Ministerial Staff. The 2026 Mission & Ministry Plan (MMP) proposal is **\$4.462.917** and represents a 2.73% increase over the current year's plan. On Wednesday evening November 5, at 6 p.m., our Executive Pastor, Kris Sullivan, will present the details of the 2026 MMP to all church members who are interested in learning more and want to ask questions about the plan. The church will also have an opportunity to consider the plan and submit questions to the church staff through email or phone call during the remainder of the month of November. During both church services on **Sunday, December 7**, the church will have an opportunity to express its desire for the plan through a voice vote.

World Mission Offering

The World Mission Offering Fund is our method of providing a way for First Baptist Church members, attenders and friends to give in one place to support several worthwhile ministries. For the current year, our church is supporting international partnerships in Thailand and Uganda, Lifeline Children's Services, and the Southern Baptist Missionary programs Lottie Moon, Annie Armstrong and Myers/Mallory.
