Peggy's Crock Pot Candy

16 oz. salted peanuts
16 oz. unsalted peanuts
2 lbs. white almond bark
8 oz. German sweet chocolate
12 oz. chocolate chips

Layer all ingredients in slow cooker as listed. Cook on low for 2-2 ½ hours. Do Not Open Crock Pot! When time is up add **1 tsp. vanilla** and stir. Drop by teaspoonful on wax paper or in one-inch candy cups. Let sit out overnight to dry. Store in refrigerator.

For a Christmas treat use decorative foil cups and substitute **red and green peanut M&M's** for some or all of the peanuts, adding them at the end when you stir the mixture.

Pat's Winter Soup

INGREDIENTS

1 lb. ground turkey OR beef
1 large onion, chopped
1 (1 oz.) package ranch dressing mix
1 (1 oz.) package taco seasoning mix
1 (16 oz.) can pinto beans
1 (16 oz.) can chili beans (hot or regular)
1 (16 oz.) can whole kernel corn
1 (8 oz.) can diced Mexican-style tomatoes
1 (8 oz.) can diced tomatoes (any flavor)

DIRECTIONS

Brown meat and onions and drain. Mix ranch dressing and taco seasoning into meat. Without draining, add all of the other ingredients. Simmer 1 hour.

(Prefer to drain the beans and corn? Just add water or stock to replace the liquid.)
