## 1. What is NTE & what's involved?

## 3. Logistics of NTE

#### Travelling

- Road trip! (Best for Echuca Mission Team)
  - Drive to Canberra over two days with a group of others across multiple cars. Leave Adelaide early on Thursday, staying overnight at Echuca, driving to Canberra on Friday.
  - At the end of NTE, drive back to Echuca on Wednesday for mission then drive back to Adelaide on Monday December 15.
- Flying (Best for Chatswood Mission Team)
  - Adelaide -> Canberra. Arrive Friday December 5. (Share uber / taxi with someone from the airport)
  - Sydney -> Adelaide. Fly out on Monday December 15 after midday.
  - We'll carpool or take a bus from Canberra to Sydney on Wednesday between conference and mission.
