Walk With God

Genesis 6:9-10 "This is the account of Noah and his family. Noah was a righteous man, the only blameless person living on earth at the time, and he walked in close fellowship with God. Noah was the father of three sons: Shem, Ham, and Japheth."

2 Peter 2:5 "And God did not spare the ancient world—except for Noah and the seven others in his family. Noah warned the world of God's righteous judgment. So God protected Noah when he destroyed the world of ungodly people with a vast flood."

Stand _____ This is the account of Noah and his family. **Noah was a righteous man...**" (v.9)

Hebrews 11:7 "It was by faith that Noah built a large boat to save his family from the flood. He obeyed God, who warned him about things that had never happened before. By his faith Noah condemned the rest of the world, and he received the righteousness that comes by faith."

James 2:23 "And so it happened just as the Scriptures say: '**Abraham believed God, and God counted him as righteous** because of his faith.' "
