¹Give thanks unto the Lord, call upon his name: make known his deeds among the people. ²Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him: talk ye of all his wondrous works. ³Glory ye in his holy name: let the heart of them rejoice that seek the Lord. ⁴Seek the Lord, and his strength: seek his face evermore. ⁵Remember his marvelous works that he hath done: his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth. -Psalm 105:1-5

This psalm first appears in 1 Chronicles 16:8-12 when Israel celebrates the return of the ark of God to Jerusalem. It reminds the people of God's reign and presence among them. King David offers praise and thanks to the Lord for "his marvelous works...his wonders, and the judgements of his mouth." David forms a choir to offer continuous praise and thanksgiving. (vv5-6) People are also assigned to play the harp, cymbals, and trumpets. It is wonderful how God uses the talents of His children to lead His congregation in worship!

Once the choir and accompanists are in place, David delivers his written song of praise (psalm) to the music leader, Asaph, and the rest of the biblical band. (v7) Verse by verse, thanksgiving, honor, blessing, and glory are lifted before the Lord in a crescendo of praise! Shoutin' time breaks loose at the conclusion of the song as all the people say "Amen" and praise the Lord together! (v36) Afterward, David assigns the choir and orchestra to "minister before the ark continually." (v37) Thanksgiving and praise should be offered before the throne of God continually and not just at scheduled times of worship. There is never a bad time to praise the Lord!

May our praise be offered regularly and not ritualistically, especially during the holiday season. May we always "Remember his marvelous works that he hath done." (v12) When we do gather for worship, as soon as the instruments strike their first note, be ready to lift your voice in thankful praise to God. We are the appointed ones to lead the praise!
