provision. We're excited to share what He's been doing!




Returning for Furlough

We will be moving to the capital city of Togo, which is Lomé, where we will be helping equip churches to multiply and be missional, so we can reach the surrounding countries. We are also going to help the board of ABWE Togo as a liaison to the government.

This fall has brought big milestones. OC officially moved into Liberty University, beginning this new life for herself. Crazy to think we have a college student (she's still our baby!) We're




praying for strong friendships, that classes would go well, and continued spiritual maturity
