Students are starting to get into the routine of things and teachers are working hard to creatively teach material in the hot classrooms. One of my favorite times of the day is 7:45 in the morning. Our students sing the national anthem and then immediately have a devotion time. This is such a great way for them to start their day. It is always a blessing to hear the students singing songs of worship during the devotion time.

God's Word is taught in every subject. They learn who God is and how they can be more like Christ as they learn math, Spanish, music, English, etc. What an honor for us to be able to teach them about the Lord and see them applying that to their lives.

Please continue to pray for our students and staff. We have about 480 students enrolled this year. We pray the Lord gives us opportunities to minister to students and their parents. Many of our students do not attend church and only hear God's Word while in the classroom.
