Twenty years ago, six pastors including myself, got together to begin a Christian camp called Grace Haven Bible Camp out of a need. This summer we hosted this camp for two weeks for several of our church plants, with over **250 participants**. One camp was for elementary students and the other for teenagers. For 20 straight years our camp has been providing kids a chance to step away from life's distractions and grow deeper in Jesus.

The camp is led entirely by volunteers from multiple churches. They are a remarkable group of Jesus-loving people devoted to raising the next generation in Christ. This fall we also hosted a **Men's Retreat** for our church plants, with several dozen men attending and enjoying rich

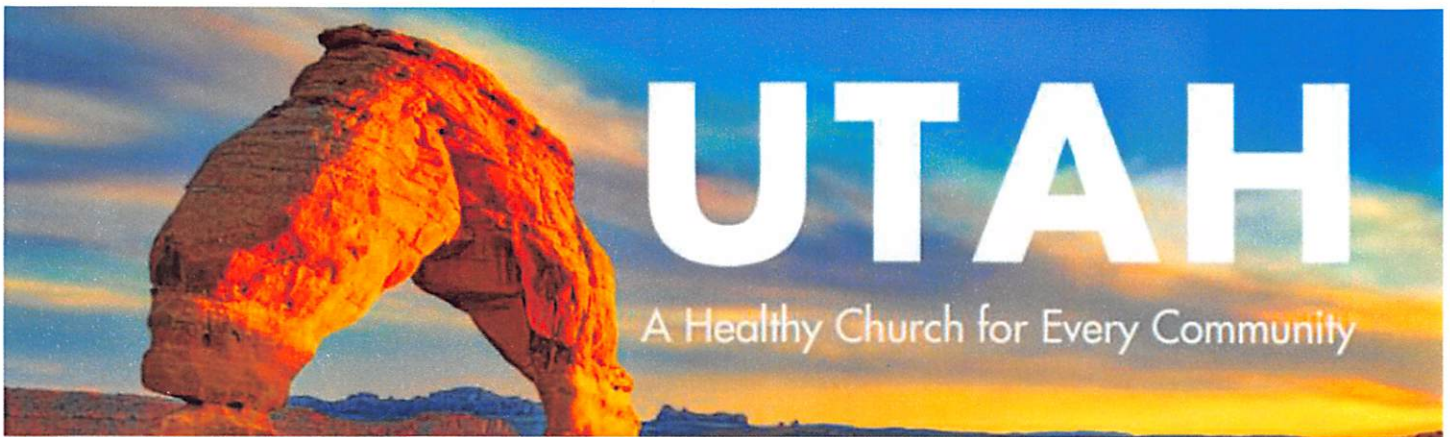
