Tithes

The term "tithe" originates from the Hebrew word meaning "tenth." It refers to the regular, intentional act of giving that believers incorporate into the rhythm of their lives. This practice reflects the conviction that God is the ultimate owner of everything and giving expresses our gratitude for His provision.

Offerings

Offerings are voluntary gifts, beyond the tithe, that the Lord places on the heart of the giver. They serve as acts of worship, gratitude, and devotion. They may be given weekly, on special occasions, or designated for a specific purpose.
