They now have received our forms, and information as of June 10th, and now we are in the waiting process for them to approve us for an in-person appointment. The in-person appointment will determine if they want to approve us for temporary residency or not. If they do not, we will still be going to Mexico, but we will then need to take a different plan of action, where we will get a normal 180 visa, and continuously go back and forth to the border to renew our visas. We are hoping to be approved for a 1yr, or 4yr temporary visa. Please pray along side us for a quick appointment date, and approval for our residency.

June 10: Sent in our forms to the Mexican Consulate in Dallas


**June 12:** Our 5 year wedding anniversary
