Happy New Year/ Feliz Año Nuevo,

Thank you to everyone who has prayed for us, encouraged us, and financially supported us in the year of 2025. We are truly blessed by the churches, and individuals that the Lord has placed in our lives, and we want you to know that we don't take for granted the relationship we have with each of you. These past few months have been busy, and blessed as usual. We thank the Lord for the work he has given us these past few months, and appreciate those of you who have reached out asking how you can pray for, or support us.

Recently we expressed to some of you the need we have within El Vástago for a new kids area. The one the church has been using is a small makeshift room in the back of a laundromat that the pastor and his wife run. The room doesn't have a door, and is very small for 20 kids ages 2-11, plus workers. With your help, we were able to raise the \$3,300 (plus some) we needed to pay the rent on a space across the hall from the main church area for a year. This will allow the kids to all meet together for the lesson time, and then the older kids will go to the original space, while the preschoolers, and babies stay in the new space, with a small wall to divide them. The new area will allow intentional time with each age group after the lesson with age appropriate recaps, and question time, along with worksheets, and toys. We appreciate your help in being able to bless the church with the space for their kids department. After 2026, we are in hopes that the church will have grown enough by then that they will be able to pay for more years on their own. The extra money will go towards other needs they have for the children's department.

Judith is starting to help in the kids department, and Cade will be starting discipleship with one of the young adult guys both at the start of this year. Cade is continuing to play guitar, and sing on Sundays, along with being in a preaching rotation with the other 2 pastors of El Vástago. We are excited to see what 2026 is going to bring.

October 31: Somos Luz

We used October 28-30 to help make handmade decorations, bag the candy and prizes, paint at the church, and restructure some things in the main area of the church. There was a group of us that came each day to help. During Somos Luz, Judith ran a game table, took pictures and videos, and Cade helped pass out prizes and run audio.





November 10: Hospital Visit

The local orphanage that attends El Vástago donated a lot of snacks to the church, but it was more than what our people needed. Heriberto decided he wanted us to visit the local hospital, and set up a table to pass out the snacks, coffee, and some food that a member had made. We were able to pray for people, be the light of Jesus, and feed them physically. Most of the people we were able to care for were there to see family members who were in the hospital. There is always a long line, and not everyone is able to go in to visit, they only allow a certain amount to go in. Many of them wait hours in the cold, only to be turned away.
