Dear Friends and Family in Christ,

Greetings from Lima! We take this opportunity to share our gratitude for all the ways the Lord has worked in our ministry this last trimester. Through every joy and trial, He has shown Himself faithful, present, and sufficient.

October was a particularly full month of ministry. Giorgio had the privilege of traveling to Cusco to teach in a pastors' training module alongside a guest pastor, Pastor Shipman. It was a rich time of teaching, encouragement, and fellowship with Andean leaders serving faithfully in their local churches. In addition, the Lord opened doors for preaching at a youth conference in Huancayo, where we were encouraged to see young people eager to grow in their faith.

In the weeks that followed, the ministry of training nationals continued. Giorgio was able to preach at a pastors' training module in Iquitos, the Amazon jungle in Perú, and later, in December, minister in Quillabamba. Each place reminded us again of the great need for sound teaching and the deep hunger for God's Word across Peru. We are continually humbled by the opportunities the Lord gives to serve His church in different regions of the country.

This trimester also brought a very difficult season for our church family. During the construction of the church building, a tragic accident occurred that brought all work to a sudden halt for several weeks. One of our volunteers had a tragic accident on the church property and passed away. This event deeply affected the entire young church and led us to a time of collective mourning, prayer, and seeking the Lord's will and guidance. It has also brought significant legal and financial challenges. We are trusting God through it all, and we kindly ask you to pray for us and for this young church. After careful review by architects, engineers, and legal counsel, we were eventually given permission to move forward with some basic aspects of the construction.
