



Mijomboni Orphanage Update

Recently, we shared that the orphanage was seeking a CCI License which was a requirement for children being able to be housed at the facility. The license has been acquired and, in addition, the Center has become an NGO (non-government organization). Our administrator is also in need of assistance to help with the day-to-day running of the facility and an additional administrator has been hired.

Nathan shares that "The Center is beginning to look at reintegration for some of the children, which will allow them to return to family members under the care of a social worker. The Kenyan government's goals are to care for whole families rather than one or two, and provide guidance on care-giving, & household economics. After completing these programs the families will

be monitored and evaluated on their economic activity to make sure they are sustainable." The Center is continuing to reach out to Send Relief for guidance on making these possible changes.

Nathan also completed a new chicken house and the parking garage for the new vehicle has been completed.


