Ultimate Wings Rescue Center

There has been a lot happening at the Rescue Center this month! We are very excited to share that the Center now has a new website https://ultimatewings.co.ke/. You can enjoy photos and stories of the children and see updates on projects and programs which are underway and being developed. Please consider sharing this site with your family and friends.





Nathan and James Baya, the social worker, are continuing to visit the homes of the children and research legal guardian status for each child. Recently, they saw good progress in one home with all the donated casava plants doing well. These plants will provide a source of nutrition and income to families. Unfortunately, they also see their share of needs in the community as was the case when they found five children in the care of a grandmother who is financially unable to care for them. None of the children had ever been to school because of the fees charged and she was struggling to feed them. Nathan stepped in and added these children to the program and they are now all attending school with uniforms and

receiving meals regularly. Three of the five have sponsors already! The other two,
Emmaculate Yvonne Mtana (15yrs) and her ten year old brother, Igoro Balozi (pictured)
are in need of sponsorship. Contact the church office if you are interested in sponsoring one of these kiddos.
The cost is \$300 a year per child.

In other news:

- The Rescue Center Board of Directors has several members who are active military. They have offered a military career to two of the children when school is finished.
- The Center also received a donation of new shoes for all the children from Nathan's son.
- Last month they had three sets of twin goats born on the same day which brings the goat herd up to 20!
- Greenlife Crop Protection Africa is now teaching families on agriculture. They are also partnering with another company to supply the Center with fruit trees next year.
- Nathan sent an ambitious five-year plan that includes developing a bee habitat next year, offering
 classes and Bible study for adults with a goal of reaching 100 people for Christ, and development of Youth
 groups with a goal of 40% of the groups being led by other youth.





SCRIPTURE READING PLAN


Join us in January as we begin a New Testament reading plan for the year. Each day we will read one chapter and each week be challenged to memorize one passage.






