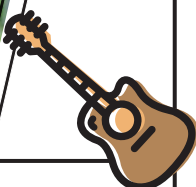
## God's Plan for Me

## CONVERSATION

### Deborah Judged the People

**JUDGES 4:1-16,23-24; 5**

The Israelites disobeyed God, so God allowed Jabin (JAY bin), the king of Canaan, to rule over them. The Israelite army was no match for King Jabin's 900 iron chariots and Sisera (SIS uh ruh), the commander of Jabin's army. For 20 years Jabin treated the people of Israel badly. Finally, the Israelites turned back to God and cried to Him for help.

Deborah was a judge of the Israelites. She helped the people understand God's laws. Each day Deborah sat under a palm tree, and the people came to her. She decided what was right or wrong for them to do.

One day Deborah called for Barak (BAY rak). Deborah reminded him that God wanted him to gather 10,000 men and lead them to Mount Tabor to fight Sisera and his soldiers.

Barak said to Deborah, "If you will go with me, I will go. But if you will not go with me, I will not go."

Deborah replied, "I will gladly go with you, but if I go, you will not receive any credit for this victory."

Barak's troops marched up Mount Tabor. When Sisera heard that Barak and his men were on top of the mountain, Sisera called for 900 chariots to go there to fight.

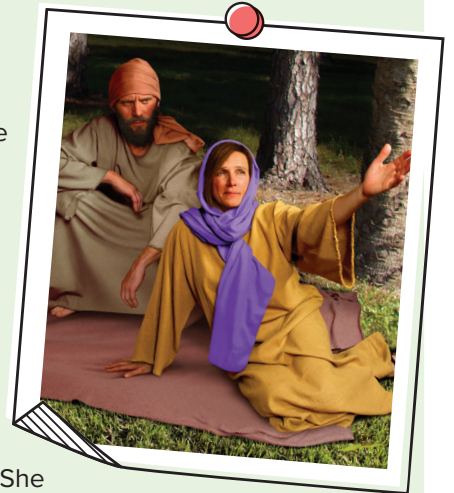
Deborah told Barak, "Go! This is the day that the Lord will hand over Sisera to you."

As Barak and his 10,000 men marched down the mountain, God confused Sisera and his men. That day God gave the Israelites victory over Sisera and his army. The Israelites defeated King Jabin and Canaan.

On that day Deborah and Barak sang a praise song to God. There was peace in the land for 40 years.

#### THE BIBLE MEETS LIFE
