

Where and When?

The Awana year begins with registration August 30th and runs through Award Night on May 1st. Clubbers check in at their designated Club desk each Wednesday evening before 6:15pm and may be picked up at their room at 7:45pm.

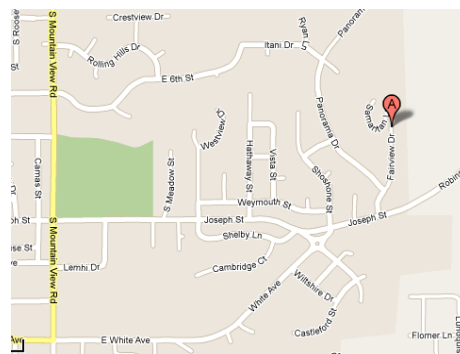

Distinctly Christian and Bible-centered, each club meeting provides start-to-finish adventure.



Game Time:

The lively, and fast paced Game Time features individual and team competition. Kids' natural energy and enthusiasm are unleashed. Kids everywhere love Awana games!

Small Group Time:

Awana handbooks emphasize memorization and understanding of key Bible verses. With a leader alongside to encourage and guide, clubbers are rewarded for their achievements as they progress through the handbooks.

Large Group/Council Time:

The whole club gathers for a Bible message, singing and announcements of upcoming events. One highlight of Large Group Time is the presentation of awards for individual handbook progress and team competition.



For the energetic 3 and 4 year olds, Cubbies is fun and exciting! Cubbies comes alongside the parents in helping clubbers memorize scripture. Cubbies learn basic truths about the Christian faith. They also have tons of fun hearing Bible stories, playing games, doing crafts and having snacks.

Cubbies must be 3 years old by September 1st and potty trained.



Five, Six and Seven year olds (K-2nd grade) enjoy the engaging Sparks curriculum, activities and group interactions to teach kids the Bible. In three years, a child will learn and review over 65 verses, many of which cover salvation and key Christian doctrine. These are key training years for our clubbers. After being immersed in solid foundational teaching at the preschool level, boys and girls frequently come to an understanding of their need to trust Christ as their personal Savior while in Sparks. We want to come alongside boys and girls and help them grow deeper in their knowledge of our Lord.



Truth & Training (3rd - 6th grade) reflects the passion of Awana to teach boys and girls the Truth of God's Word and to train them to follow Christ in their daily lives. T&T is the program that trains the leaders of tomorrow - today. Through weekly club meetings, we expose children to the gospel message, Scripture memory, Bible study, and fun! The Bible centered curriculum helps kids build a firm foundation for their faith, hide God's Word in their heart and apply the truths of Scripture to their daily lives.



Aimed at 7th grade and older, Trek provides solid Biblical teaching with relevant applications. The Bible study deals with trials, temptations and tough times of the Christian life. No one escapes these difficult times. How do students respond when life comes crashing down around them? Trek helps the middle school and older student prepare for what lies ahead! Students may also become Jr. Leaders, helping out in Cubbies or Sparks.

Trek will only be held if we have 4 or more Clubbers register at the beginning of each year.
