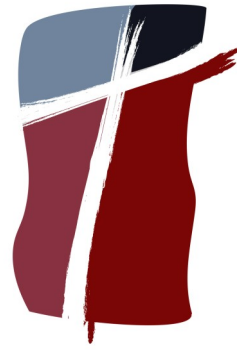
Salt and Light Together

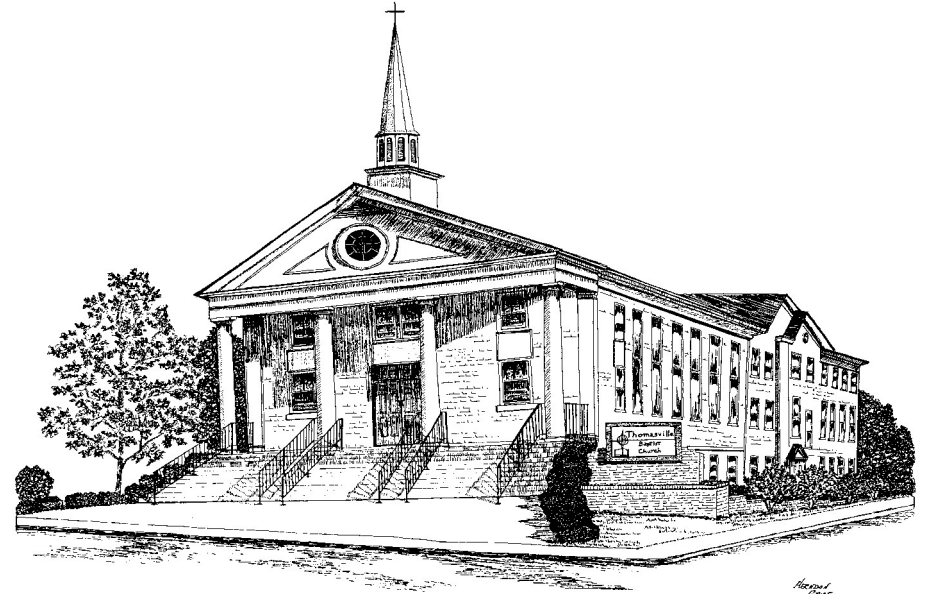

Deacon Nominations Policy

“In the months of September and October, all voting members of the church will have the opportunity to nominate resident male church members to be a deacon. These members should get a copy of the deacon qualifications and deacon questionnaire from the office, meet individually with the proposed candidate for deacon, go over the qualifications for a deacon as written in the policy, and have the candidate fill out the deacon questionnaire which assures that the candidate is qualified and willing to serve if elected. These nominations must be submitted to the church office by the end of October. After the time for nominations is over, the deacons will meet and review the list of candidates that have been nominated. Any candidate that has been nominated can be refused by the deacon body if they are in agreement by a 2/3 vote that the candidate that has been nominated is not qualified. After being reviewed, the deacons will then present a list of an unspecified number of candidates to the church for deacon election on a written ballot prepared by the church at which time the church will vote for the men they deem most suitable to serve as deacons for the number of positions that are vacant.”
