- -What does it mean to be saved? What is salvation? What are we saved from?

- -God loved us so much he took action John 3:16 page 107
- -Jesus came to save us from God's judgement of sin.
- -Jesus rescues us from sin. If we receive Jesus he gives us a new heart. We are restored!

Guess what! You are made new at the time of salvation!

2 Corinthians 5:17 states, "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.". This verse signifies that when a person comes to faith in Christ, they experience a fundamental change in their life and identity, becoming a new person with a new beginning. Page 221

Here's a breakdown of the key elements of the verse:

• "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ...":

This establishes a conditional statement: if a person is in Christ, meaning they have a relationship with him through faith, then the following is true.

• "...he is a new creation":

This highlights the transformative nature of faith. A person is not merely reformed or improved; they are created anew, with a new nature and purpose.

• "the old things have passed away":

The old life, with its habits, desires, and relationships, is no longer relevant.

• "behold, all things have become new":

This emphasizes the complete renewal of the individual's life. Everything, including their outlook, values, and goals, is transformed by this new creation.
