



#### WE LOVE OUR LOCAL DO GOOD PARTNERSHIPS

















Over the past year we have been able to partner in unique and specific ways locally through our local DO GOOD partnerships. Through these partnership we have supported **12 un-housed families** with meals, Provided new moms with needed resources for their babies and families, provided over **500 pairs of shoes** for kids going to school, served **60 Teachers and 600 students** in Pink Elementary, cared for over **30 Single moms** taking needed next steps, supported **8 field ministers** and **baptized 84 men** in Jester III. Glory To GOD!



#### WE LOVE OUR GLOBAL DO GOOD PARTNERSHIPS













Through our global partnerships we are able to connect with many areas of the world including **Guatemala**, **Nicaragua**, **Peru**, **Pakistan**, **Sri Lanka**, and **India**. Many of our partnerships are connected with un-reached people groups and carry the HOPE of Jesus into areas where people have not yet heard about Him. Over the last year we were able to go on **4 global trips** (over 40 participants), sharing the gospel with nearly **1,000 people**, and **217** came to faith in Jesus. In addition to our trips, through our Global DO GOOD Partners we provided **52,000 meals**, support a school of over **100 students** in Nicaragua, church planting efforts in Peru, and relational evangelism in Pakistan. And that **coffee we drink on Sunday**...Comes straight from Guatemala through our partnership with 410 Bridge!





In **July 2024 Hurricane Beryl** hit our community and caused power outages and damages to homes and property. This left many without food and water. As a team we came together to build a plan for The Bridge to respond in order to help. We began to pair needs with resources and is was amazing to see The Bridge step up in a big way. From equipment to gift cards, clean up to repairs - the church was there for one another, reminding us that we are not alone.

Through your generosity, time, and efforts we were able to serve **over 70 families**, rebuilding, restocking the fridge, providing clothes, and much more.

There are so many ways we care for one another here at The Bridge. Through our DO GOOD ministry we are able to offer counseling, some financial assistance, grief support, and prayer & presence as **we walk through the highs and lows of life**. We are committed to reminding each other we are not alone!

**Did you know:** We have a Director of Care, Greg Tyler, that walks through planning a funeral for your loved one, an upcoming wedding, and other needs as they arise. We are here to support and walk with you and your family. Over the past year we have served **over 20 families** with benevolent financial support, as well as overseeing funerals and weddings for our partners.





Each year at Christmas time, **Small Groups** at **The Bridge** are given he opportunity to **DO GOOD**. Each group is given funds to use to serve in our community. This past December, our small groups showed up big! We love this opportunity for our small groups to partner with current and new partner in our community to share the love of Jesus, Carry Hope, and DO GOOD!
