The Biblical Epic: Old Testament Roots and New Testament Fulfillment

Join us at 10:30 AM starting September 14, 2025, as we begin a new class taught by Rick Carmickle tracing the story of redemption from its Old Testament roots to its New Testament reality fulfilled in Jesus Christ. This fall, our emphasis will be the Old Testament foundations. Our class will connect the dots of Scripture to uncover the unified narrative of God's redemptive plan, and how God's plan began with a couple in a garden, then expanded to a family, a tribe, a nation, a kingdom, and finally to his church.

Our journey through the biblical narrative—following its theological message—will help you appreciate how the 66 books of the Bible fit together by exploring the biblical story in the context in its ancient world. We will learn to appreciate what life was like in antiquity and realize the benefits of understanding its culture through its history, literature, geography, and archaeology. Our learning through the weekly lessons will be enhanced with hundreds of photographs of ancient artifacts, illustrations, landscapes, maps, and diagrams to help our comprehension.

Our sessions will trace the scope of salvation history from Eden's promise in Genesis to the glorious New Heavens and New Earth in Revelation, revealing how Jesus Christ fulfills God's eternal purpose. But we will see how God revealed all this through the lens of the world of people that lived long ago and far away.

These sessions will deepen your faith and equip you to see Scripture as narrating God's one big story of redemption. Perfect for believers seeking a richer understanding of the Bible, this class combines theological depth with practical insights, connecting ancient promises to their New Testament reality and your future destiny.

Marriage Mentoring

Are you newly married and feel you would like a little guidance as your relationship grows and changes? Perhaps you have been married long enough that busyness and complacency has created drift and your relationship is 'just OK'. Have you lost a child, in a blended family, or other major life event and would like to connect with another couple who understands the unique challenges you face? Maybe you are in a healthy marriage but want it to be even better.

LBC has trained marriage mentors with life experiences to encourage you no matter how you would describe your marriage. Mentors will be there to cheer you when you are doing well and help give attention to areas you want to strengthen so that small irritations don't become major issues. There is usually a lot of laughter and sometimes tears, as couples share from their hearts.

The plan is for a mentor and mentee couple to meet once a month for a year to explore topics such as Money, Pace and Priorities, Gratitude and Forgiveness and others. You choose the topic each month.
