### SUMMER CLASS: Lesson 11: "Evangelism and the Believer"

In Lesson 11, Evangelism and the Believer, we'll reclaim the biblical vision for reaching the lost, not with fear, but with clarity, compassion, and conviction.

We'll explore what it means to "make disciples," how to clearly explain the gospel, and how to live in such a way that your life authenticates your message. We'll answer key questions about how to speak truth in love, how to respond to questions with gentleness, and how to trust God with the results. Evangelism is not about employing cunning arguments, manipulative strategies, or superficial emotional appeals, but about simply and clearly proclaiming the gospel, acknowledging that only God can open hearts and bring about conversion.

You'll be equipped with biblical essentials, a practical strategy, and the confidence that evangelism is not about ability—but availability. This lesson will prepare you to "always be ready" with the hope you have in Christ. Come ready to be challenged, equipped, and used by God.

## Marriage Mentoring

Are you newly married and feel you would like a little guidance as your relationship grows and changes? Perhaps you have been married long enough that busyness and complacency has created drift and your relationship is 'just OK'. Have you lost a child, in a blended family, or other major life event and would like to connect with another couple who understands the unique challenges you face? Maybe you are in a healthy marriage but want it to be even better.

LBC has trained marriage mentors with life experiences to encourage you no matter how you would describe your marriage. Mentors will be there to cheer you when you are doing well and help give attention to areas you want to strengthen so that small irritations don't become major issues. There is usually a lot of laughter and sometimes tears, as couples share from their hearts.

The plan is for a mentor and mentee couple to meet once a month for a year to explore topics such as Money, Pace and Priorities, Gratitude and Forgiveness and others. You choose the topic each month.
