Key Scriptures

Start Thinking. Ask questions to get your group thinking.

- Jesus is a king like no other. What are some things about Jesus' life that were unexpected? What do those things tell you about who He is?
- We can have three responses to Jesus' kingship: opposition, dismissal, and worship. Have you ever opposed or dismissed Jesus? What led you to eventually worship Him instead?
- How do you most enjoy worshiping Jesus?
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Start Sharing. Choose questions that create openness.

- What are some ways you can bow down and worship Jesus this Christmas season?
- How can you share Jesus with your friends and family this Christmas season?

Start Praying. Be bold, and pray specifically.

Father, thank You for Your Son. Thank You for the life He lived and the price He paid for all of us. Help us not get carried away by the busyness of this Christmas season and instead give us hearts to worship Him for all He's done. In Jesus' name, amen.

Start Doing. Commit to a step, and live it out this week.
