### **Key Scripture**

Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! #### Start Talking: Find a conversation starter for your group.

• Share one thing you're passionate about.

#### Start Thinking. Ask questions to get your group thinking.

- Read **2 Corinthians 5:17-21**. God says you are His ambassador. How does this truth make you feel? What does it tell you about God?
- What are some barriers that prevent people from living as Christ's ambassadors?

#### Start Sharing. Choose questions that create openness.

- Share about a time when you were rejected. How has that experience influenced the way you engage with others? How can the truth that God has chosen you change the way you view yourself?
- Talk about what it looks like to bring heaven to earth. What does this mean to you, and how can you focus on this mission this week?

#### Start Praying. Be bold, and pray specifically.

Father, thank You for calling us Your ambassadors. We want to represent You well to the people around us in our home, at work, and in our day-to-day lives. We're choosing to step into the authority You've given us so we can grow Your Kingdom. In Jesus' name, amen.

#### Start Doing. Commit to a step, and live it out this week.

- Take one step this week to reflect God's Kingdom to those around you. Share about your experience with your Connect Group.
- Consider how you could love others by serving on the weekend or with a Local Mission Partner.
