- 2. Why did Jonah say no to God and try to run? Have you ever had a bad idea like Jonah?
- 3. Think about a time you tried to run from God. Explain.
- 4. Why did God send a great storm on the sea? What was the reaction of the sailors?
- 5. Has God ever sent a storm into your life? Why?
- 6. What was Jonah doing as everyone prayed? Why?
- 7. Is there any area of your life where God wants you to wake up? Explain.
- 8. Was the storm Jonah's fault? Why or why not?
- 9. How did Jonah "own his own junk?" Why was it important for Jonah to be honest?
- 10. What does it mean for us to be honest and own our own junk?
- 11. Why did Jonah tell the sailors to throw him overboard? What other options were there?
- 12. As soon as Jonah went overboard the seas became calm. Why?
- 13. In what areas of our lives do we need to acknowledge that God is in control?
