

Text: *Jonah* 1:1-16

- 1. When was the last time you heard an "outrageous God (fish) story." What was your reaction?
- 2. Why did God allow Jonah to be swallowed by a huge fish?
- 3. In Jonah 1:17-2:1, we discover that Jonah's fish struggles were part of God's divine plan.

 Think of a time when God was "unbelievably" leading you? What was your response?
- 4. Have you ever struggled to follow God's leading? Why or why not?
- 5. What was God trying to teach Jonah in the belly of this fish? How can our "fish struggles" cause us to pray more?
- 6. In Jonah 2:2-7, we hear Jonah's psalm of praise. What miracles does Jonah recall from his 3 days and 3 nights in the belly of a sea monster?
- 7. Miracle #1: How did God save Jonah's life (Jonah 2:2)? How has God saved your life?
- 8. Miracle #2: How do we know that God saw Jonah's future (Jonah 2:3-4)? Looking back, can you see how God was leading you into the future you are now living?
- 9. Miracle #3: How do we know that God head Jonah's prayers (Jonah 2:5-7)?
- 10. How has God answered your prayers in difficult seasons? What would you say to someone who doesn't believe in God or in prayer?
- 11. How and why did Jonah decide to become obedient to God and His plan (Jonah 2:8-10)?
- 12. How does obedience to God open the door to God's blessings?
- 13. Jonah was vomited up on the shore by God's divine hand. How should the story of Jonah and a big fish impact our lives today? Explain.
