3. The word "better" in the Hebrew means, "best, beautiful, bountiful, sweet, pleasant, and as good as gold." What comes to your mind when you hear the word "better?"
4. Why does the Psalmist declare that it's better to live in the courts of God than anywhere else? How should we feel about being in God's Presence?
5. Where would you love to be right now if you could be anywhere on earth? Why?
6. Doorkeepers of the Temple were also gatekeepers. Why was this job so crucial? (1 Chronicles 9:22-23 & 1 Chronicles 6:22-24)
7. Who was Lot? Why did he choose to pitch his tent toward Sodom? (Genesis 13:12-13)
8. Why did God send angels to Sodom? Where was Lot when they arrived? (Genesis 19:1-2)
9. What does the Psalmist mean when he writes that it's better to be a doorkeeper in God's House than to live in the tent of the wicked?
10. Why is it tempting to live life in a way that God doesn't want us to live?
11. Who does Jesus say He is in John 10:7-10? What did Jesus come to do for us?
12. What does "better is one day" mean to you?
