- 3. The word "better" in the Hebrew means, "best, beautiful, bountiful, sweet, pleasant, and as good as gold." What comes to your mind when you hear the word "better?"
- 4. Why does the Psalmist declare that it's better to live in the courts of God than anywhere else? How should we feel about being in God's Presence?
- 5. Where would you love to be right now if you could be anywhere on earth? Why?
- 6. Doorkeepers of the Temple were also gatekeepers. Why was this job so crucial? (1 Chronicles 9:22-23 & 1 Chronicles 6:22-24)
- 7. Who was Lot? Why did he choose to pitch his tent toward Sodom? (Genesis 13:12-13)
- 8. Why did God send to angels to Sodom? Where was Lot when they arrived? (Genesis 19:1-2)
- 9. What does the Psalmist mean when he writes that it's better to be a doorkeeper in God's House than to live in the tent of the wicked?
- 10. Why is it tempting to live life in a way that God doesn't want us to live?
- 11. Who does Jesus say He is in John 10:7-10? What did Jesus come to do for us?
- 12. What does "better is one day" mean to you?
