- 5. What does it mean to give up our power or control to God?
- 6. Read Luke 19:4-7. What did the crowd think when Zacchaeus climbed a tree to see Jesus?
- 7. What was the motive for Jesus to invite himself to Zacchaeus' house for lunch?
- 8. What part does pride play in our desire for power, prestige and possessions? How would your pride have to die in order to have a life-changing encounter with Jesus?
- 9. Read Luke 19:8. Why did Zacchaeus give up his possessions once he spent time with Jesus? What "possession" do you need to give up to Live to Give?
- 10. Read Luke 19:9-10. What does the word passion mean to you? What does "the passion of the Christ" refer to?
- 11. Jesus said "salvation has come to this house?" What was Jesus' passion on this earth?
- 12. What will God require from us to begin to Live to Give?
