

Text: Psalm 84:11-12

- 1. What has been an unforgettable lesson you've learned from Psalm 84?
- 2. What does it mean to trust in God? Give an example from your own life?
- 3. In what ways has the Psalmist had to learn to trust in God throughout his journey?
- 4. In Psalm 84:11a we read, "For the LORD God is a sun ...". How did God warm and protect the Psalmist? How does God warm and protect us?
- 5. In John 8:12, Jesus said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." How is Jesus the (sun) light of the world?
- 6. To trust in God, we must be willing to prepare for battle and "raise the shield." How can we use faith in God as a shield to protect our lives?
- 7. To trust in God, we must make room for His favor. What does God's favor look like in our lives? Explain how God's favor can also mean "God's grace." What is grace?
- 8. What kind of things clutter up our lives? What kind of junk or excess baggage do we need to get rid of to make room for God's favor?
- 9. In 2 Corinthians 6:1-3, the Apostle Paul writes ... "As God's co-workers we urge you not to receive God's grace in vain. For he says, 'In the time of my favor I heard you, and in the day of salvation I helped you.' I tell you, now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation." What does Paul mean when he tells us, "Now is the time of God's favor?"
- 10. In Psalm 84:11 we read, "No good thing does He withhold from those whose walk is blameless." What does the word good mean?
- 11. Even when life is so hard to handle, does God still shower us with His goodness? Explain.
- 12. What does it mean to live a blameless life? Does God expect perfection?
- 13. God wants to bless His children who demonstrate integrity. What does integrity look like today in our world?

  What should integrity look like in followers of Jesus?
- 14. Psalm 84:12 says, "LORD Almighty, blessed is the one who trusts in you." What does God want you to do to trust in Him more right now?
