WHEN IS AWANA?

Awana is our Wednesday evening discipleship program for children during the academic year, from September through May.

WHAT TIME DOES IT BEGIN & END?

Check in begins at **6:20pm**. Please keep your children under your supervision until that time. Dismissal time is **8:00pm**. For security reasons children are released to parents only.

HOW CAN YOU HELP YOUR CHILD BE PREPARED?

Please ensure children bring their **bag, Bible, and handbook**. Coming to Club without handbooks results in an inability to participate in book time. The clubber is frustrated, and often becomes a distraction to others who are working in their handbooks. Coming to Club without a handbook is like being at school without pencil, paper, and books. Please be reminded that handbook time is to recite what the children have prepared during the week at home. We encourage you to review the verses with your child at home to prepare for Awana on Wednesday.

WHAT DOES MY CLUBBER WEAR?

Clubbers are expected to wear their **uniforms** each week. Clubbers will be participating in Game Square. K-5th grade will go outside, weather permitting, so please have clubbers wear **closed-toe shoes** and proper outerwear for cool weather.

WHAT ARE THE FEES?

In an effort to simplify the registration process, Faithbridge collects a one-time annual fee at registration. Registration for the 2025-26 year for Faithbridgers is **\$50.00** with a \$100 maximum per family. For those that attend other churches and would like to attend our Awana program the cost is \$75 with a \$150 maximum per family. All materials your clubber requires will be ordered for them once registration is completed.

WHAT IS THE AWANA STORE?

Awana Store is held twice annually – the last week before Christmas break and the last night of Club, the week before Closing Ceremonies. As Awana is a rewards-based program, clubbers earn credit to purchase items from the store.
