WORSHIP WHOLEHEARTEDLY

Our WALK leads us to attract others to Jesus. The monthly prayer cues and action steps that follow help us to be intentional with those around us everyday.

One-sentence prayers can help us focus on the presence of God amid busy days, in the middle of meetings, or absolutely anywhere we find ourselves. These simple prayers help us to have a mindset of worship.

ONE-SENTENCE-PRAYERS

ATTRACT OTHERS TO JESUS

Our WALK leads us to attract others to Jesus. The monthly prayer cues and action steps that follow help us to be intentional with those around us everyday.

JANUARY

PRAY FOR YOUR NEIGHBORS

Pray that God would open your eyes to specific, tangible needs in their neighbors' lives and grant them the courage and wisdom to share the hope of Christ.

ACTION

Perform anonymous, practical acts of service for your neighbors (e.g., clearing leaves, bringing treats) to create opportunities for genuine conversation and spiritual connection.

FEBRUARY

PRAY FOR LOCAL LEADERS & GOVERNMENT

Pray for the salvation and godly wisdom of city council members, police officers, and school administrators, asking that their influence prepares hearts for the Gospel.

ACTION

Write your local leaders and ask, "How can we help your efforts to bless this city?" and then bring those ideas to the church.

MARCH

PRAY FOR THE BROKEN AND MARGINALIZED

Pray that Seymour Heights' outreach efforts in the community would be seen as genuine love and a direct invitation to find their refuge in Jesus.

ACTION

Serve at or collect food for CROSS Food Ministries, or participate in a service project with Live-It Ministries.

APRIL

PRAY FOR THE SUCCESS OF THE HUB

Pray for the HUB to be a powerful witnessing tool through all it has to offer.

ACTION

Invite others who are outside of the church to participate in activities held in the HUB

MAY

PRAY FOR OUR IDENTITY IN SEYMOUR

Pray that Seymour Heights would be known for its unwavering unity, radical generosity, and tangible love, serving as a powerful, living testimony of Jesus in our corner of the Kingdom.

ACTION

Create your own *Radical Generosity Challenge*: commit a small amount weekly to spontaneously bless someone outside the church—a stranger, a server, etc.—and share the story of the reaction.

JUNE

PRAY FOR JESUS' PRESENCE IN LOCAL BUSINESS

Pray that Christian workers in these places would be bold witnesses, and that God would use the workplace as a primary harvest field.

ACTION

Pick a local business to pray over. Pray at the doors of or inside the business for the employees, and send notes of encouragement to the employees.

JULY

PRAY FOR OPEN DOORS TO LOCAL SCHOOLS

Pray for unusual favor and access for Seymour Heights to serve within public schools.

ACTION

Adopt a local school. Commit to a monthly presence, such as providing treats for teachers' lounges or mentoring students.

AUGUST

PRAY FOR INDIGENOUS CHURCH PLANTING

Pray that Seymour Heights supported missionaries' work results in rapid, self-sustaining, and culturally-relevant local churches led by indigenous believers.

ACTION

Sign up for the newsletter of one of Seymour Heights supported missions to receive direct, personal updates on their growth and challenges.

SEPTEMBER

PRAY FOR OUR CONNECTION TO OUR MISSIONARIES

Pray that the congregation would feel a deep, personal burden and commitment for the supported missions.

ACTION

Prayerfully consider participating in a short-term mission trip.

NOVEMBER

PRAY FOR THE PERSECUTED

Pray for the Holy Spirit to break down cultural and spiritual strongholds and prepare countless hearts to hear and believe the Gospel message. Pray for those who risk their lives to share the Gospel.

ACTION

Go to *persecution.com* and choose an action from the "Get Involved" tab.

OCTOBER

PRAY FOR PROTECTION OF OUR MISSIONARIES

Choose a missionary from the Mission Wall and pray specifically for the physical safety, emotional resilience, and spiritual health of that missionary.

ACTION

If possible, send care packages and notes of encouragement over the next twelve months.

DECEMBER

PRAY FOR STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS & RESOURCES

Pray that our supported missions would receive the exact financial and human resources they need to multiply their impact.

ACTION

Consider giving a year-end gift to one of Seymour Heights supported missions or giving a year-end gift to Seymour Heights mission's fund.

LIVE TRANSFORMED LIVES

Our WALK leads us to live transformed lives. Life transformation doesn't happen in a snap, it is a daily submission to the Lord.

“Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.”

ROMANS 12:2

If you have accepted Jesus through confession, repentance, and baptism, the Holy Spirit is working on you, wanting to make you more like Jesus. Each day, we have the choice: either resist that transformation or welcome it. So let's make the most of each day and seek His transformation.

Is there a certain sin that is keeping you from living the way that Jesus has called you to?

We can turn from our sin and choose God's way every day. As it says in Lamentations:

“The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.” (3:22-23)

MORNING ORIENTATION

Commit to praying this prayer every morning and insert the sin that you struggle to overcome.

SUPPORT & ACCOUNTABILITY
