SECTION 1: FAN THE FLAME

Main Teaching Summary:

You are gifted, but the gift must be stirred. Passion is not optional—it's part of your spiritual armor. God gave you power, love, and self-discipline to fully walk in your calling.

Key Scriptures:

- 2 Timothy 1:6–7
- Jeremiah 20:9
- Isaiah 59:17

Write out one or more of these scriptures below:

Reflection Questions:

- What gifts has God placed inside you that need stirring?
- Where have you become passive or casual in your faith?
- How would your life change if you lived with holy passion?

Personal Application:

Identify one gift or area of calling you've neglected. Write a plan to fan it into flame this week.

Prayer Prompt:

God, stir up the fire in me again. I don't want to be passive—I want to burn with purpose.

SECTION 2: SAVED & CALLED

Main Teaching Summary:

God didn't just save you to survive—He called you to live a holy, set-apart life that impacts others. There is no such thing as “saved but not called.”

Key Scriptures:

- 2 Timothy 1:8–9
- 1 Peter 2:11

Write out one or more of these scriptures below:

Reflection Questions:

- Have you been living like someone who's saved but not called?
- What does living with eternity in mind look like practically?
- Are your current dreams aligned with God's purpose?

Personal Application:

Write down one area of your life where you need to shift your focus from temporary to eternal.

Prayer Prompt:

Father, remind me daily that I'm not just saved—I'm called. Help me live on purpose.

SECTION 3: CALLED TO MORE

Main Teaching Summary:

You were never called to play it safe. Like Paul and Silas, you're anointed to disrupt darkness, disturb the enemy, and turn the world upside down.

Key Scriptures:

- Acts 17:4–6
- 1 Corinthians 9:16

Reflection Questions:

- What keeps you from stepping fully into your calling?
- Where are you playing it safe instead of living bold?
- What would a “world-turning” step of faith look like for you?

Personal Application:

Describe a bold step God is asking you to take. Write it out and commit to action.

Prayer Prompt:

Lord, I say yes to disruption. Use me to shake the status quo and shine Your light.

SECTION 4: UNIQUELY GIFTED

Main Teaching Summary:

You don't have to do everything—you just have to do your part. Your gift is unique and vital to God's plan. Fulfillment comes from working your grace zone.

Key Scriptures:

- 1 Corinthians 3:6–8
- Romans 12:6–11

Write out one or more of these scriptures below:

Reflection Questions:

- What's one unique gift or skill God has given you?
- How can you use that gift more faithfully?
- Are you celebrating others' roles or comparing?

Personal Application:

List 1–3 gifts you have and brainstorm specific ways to activate them this season.

Prayer Prompt:

God, thank You for the gift You placed in me. I choose to use it well—for Your glory.

SECTION 5: ATTEMPT GREAT THINGS

Main Teaching Summary:

God is not glorified by small, safe dreams. Attempt something great. Think bigger. Pray bolder. Believe for the impossible. The world needs your faith.

Key Scriptures:

- Isaiah 54:2–3
- Daniel 11:32

Reflection Questions:

- What's one big thing God has placed on your heart?
- Have you been shrinking back out of fear or doubt?
- What would it look like to attempt something great in faith?

Personal Application:

Write a bold faith goal—something only God could do—and take your first step toward it.

Prayer Prompt:

Jesus, I want to attempt great things for You. Stretch my faith and use my life for exploits.
