IV. Old Testament Example – 2 Kings 4:1–7

The widow's oil shows God using what we have to bring us into what we don't have.

What 'empty jars' (people or opportunities) can you begin filling today?

V. Multiplication in the Covenant – Deuteronomy 8:7–13

God promises abundance, nothing lacking, and multiplication.

What 'streams of provision' has God opened in your life?

How can you steward them for Kingdom multiplication?

VI. Multiplication in the Early Church – Acts 2:41–47

The church grew rapidly through daily devotion, fellowship, and worship.

What daily habits could you implement to make space for God's multiplication?

How could your small group or church embody this Acts 2 model?

VII. Kingdom Principle of Giving – Deuteronomy 15:10

God blesses cheerful and willing giving; multiplication follows generous action.

How does your attitude toward giving impact what God can multiply in your life?

What step of generosity could you take this week?

VIII. Final Exhortation

Move from weekly to daily faithfulness; walk in the anointing of multiplication to fulfill your calling.
