## Righteous Suffering 1 Peter 3:13-22

Peter is writing to a church in the middle of suffering persecution for their faith. The persecution is a current reality to them. Peter points them to the ultimate reality found in their hope and faith in the Lord Jesus. It is the nature of that reality and the concept of submission, which Peter uses to help the believers deal with their current situation.

Chapters 1-2 Peter writes about how to live in the community of faith in such times. Beginning at 2:13 Peter writes about Living in the World as a believer. The key word is "Submission." Submission to Government: [2:13-17]; Submission in work [2:18-25]; Submission in Marriage [3:1-7]; Submission in all of life [3:8-12].
